1. Students who transfer with an A.A. in Business Administration from Bermuda College will be required to complete Temple's 45+ General Education requirements. Courses recommended in this agreement satisfy requirements of the 45+ General Education program. Students transferring without one of these courses may require additional time to degree completion.
2. Students should select EES L*** or PHY 1121: Principles of Physics I. EES 1101 transfers to Temple as EES 0842: Sustainable Environments. PHY 1121 transfers to Temple as PHYS 1021: Intro to General Physics I. These courses satisfying Temple's Science & Technology (GS) GenEd area. Students transferring to Temple without one of these courses may require additional time to degree completion.
3. Students should select HIS 1140: World History I or HIS 1141: World History II. HIS 1140 transfers to Temple as HIST 171: Ancient World to 1500. HIS 1141 transfers to Temple as HIST 1702: Mod History Since 1500. These courses satisfying Temple's World Society (GG) GenEd area. Students transferring to Temple without one of these courses may require additional time to degree completion.
4. The combination on MAT 2233: Statistics I and MAT 2234: Statistics II satisfies STAT 2103: Statistical Business Analytics, a major requirement at Temple.
5. Human Resource Management majors are encouraged to take MNG 2110: Marketing Management I. Accounting or Entrepreneurship majors are encouraged to take ACC 2253: Management Accounting I.
6. Students should select MSC 1103: Music Appreciation. MSC 1103 transfers to Temple as MUST L*** and satisfies the Arts (GA) GenEd requirement. Students transferring without this course may require additional time to degree completion.
