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Notes: Students following this plan are under the GenEd-45+ General Education program.

- a) Temple University requires that all undergraduate degree candidates complete 45 hours of the last 60 hours of the degree or program as matriculated students at Temple University. If a matriculated student previously took Temple courses on a non-matriculated basis, those courses are counted towards this requirement.
- b) Students who take courses at MCCC that transfer as equivalents to Temple Gen Ed requirements will need to make up the difference with elective credits. For example, if a math course is taken that is equivalent to the GQ requirement, 4 elective credits will need to be taken instead.
- c) Students must select one of the following MSP concentrations: Media Production, Media Business, and Media Analysis. Students must take a minimum of 18 credits of Concentration Course Options, including at least two (2) courses at EITHER the 2000 or 3000 level. Additional concentration credits will count as electives. Students can take a maximum of 64 credits in MSP that count toward graduation.
- d) For students who have taken MSP 278 at MCCC, the Temple equivalent MSP 2701 satisfies a Media Production Concentration requirement. Students in the Media Production Concentration should select a free elective instead.
- e) All students must take a minimum of two writing-intensive (WI) courses in the major at Temple. WI courses end in the numbers 96, 97, or 98.
