- 2. Temple's Facilities Management program will accept by DARS exception the combination of HACC's ARCH 101, 102, 111, and 241 to fulfill the required ARCH 1011 and ARCH 1012.
- 3. Temple's Facilities Management program will accept by DARS exception the combination of HACC's ARCH 201 and 202 to fulfill the required ARCH 2123/ARCH 2153 and ARCH 2124/ARCH 2154 course combinations.
- MATH 121: Calculus I will substitute for the Math 1031 Differential and Integral Calculus requirement for the BS in Facilities Management.
- 5. Temple's Facilities Management program will accept by DARS exception the combination of HACC's ARCH 110, ARCH 130, and ARCH 135to fulfill two required courses at Temple: ARCH 2151 and ARCH 3152. Completing the ARCH 110, 130 and 135 at HACC will allow the students to move through the degree as outlined in the agreement.
- 6. HACC graduates who transfer with the A.A. in Architecture satisfy Temple's GenEd requirements by GenEd-to-GenEd transfer. It is recommended that students work with their HACC advisor to select transferable courses for their electives that fulfill the needed HACC degree requirements.



If the suggested classes are successfully completed, an Associate in Arts in Architecture is awarded from HACC, the remaining two years in the Facilities Management Program follows:
