Next Steps

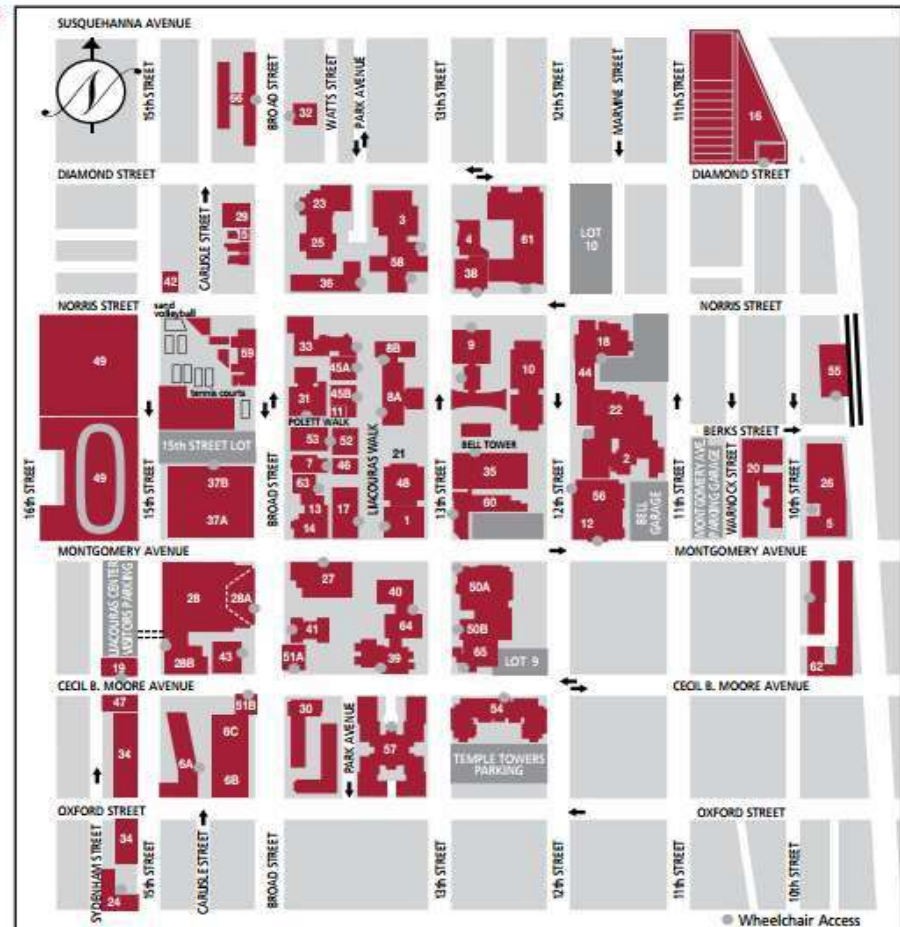
- Take a [campus tour](#)! Tours leave at 10am and 1pm daily from the Welcome Center (Map #55)
